Crisis

Rankings



- At the end of each committee session, the director and staff rank the top delegates
 - Top Ten
 - All General and Specialized Assembly committees except ...
 - Top Five
 - NATO, Security Council, Press Corps
 - All Crisis committees
- Delegates receive an equivalent number of points
 - **First** = five or ten, depending, **Second** = four or nine, and so on

Position Papers



- All committees with position papers (optional or required) will have a position paper award
- The position paper award equals one point toward delegate totals

Delegate Awards



- Every committee receives
 - Best Delegate
 - Outstanding Delegate
 - Honorable Delegate
- Some committees receive verbal awards at Director's discretion
- Ineligibility
 - Missed a session
 - Didn't turn in a position paper when it was required

Delegation Awards



- We total the point rankings from each session for all delegates
 - This includes the position paper awards
 - General Assembly points (top five) are divided by two so that these positions are weighted evenly with crisis positions
- These totals are then divided by the number of *positions*, not delegates
 - This is why I've kept bothering you about what exact drops you have!
 - Dual-delegations are counted as one position
- For delegates that are ineligible for individual awards
 - Their position still counts in the delegation total positions
 - Their total points still count toward the delegation total points

Delegation Awards cont.



- Divisions are decided to make the three categories as even as possible ($\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{3}$)
- Our website has always specified that these numbers are subject to change

For GatorMUN XV:

- 1-9: Small Delegations
- 10-19: Medium Delegations
- 20+: Large Delegations
